# Literacy

- We will share stories about superheroes.
- > I will practise continuing a rhyming string.
- > I will use my sound knowledge to write words and build sentences, starting to work more independently.
- > I will practise using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- > I will learn about the beginning, middle and end of stories.
- I will create my own superhero character and use descriptive language.
- > I will create my own superhero story.
- In phonics, I will finish learning the phase 3 sounds and tricky words and practise applying all the sounds and words we have learnt

# Communication and Language

- I will listen to stories and rhymes and develop the skills I need to become a good listener.
- > I will practise talking about myself and listening carefully to my friends.
- > I will share my own knowledge and try to answer questions appropriately.
- I will practise listening to classroom visitors about their occupations and ask relevant questions, using 'why, who, what, when and how'.
- > We will develop our vocabulary and start using more complex sentences.

We all know about Batman and Spiderman...but who are our real-life superheroes? How can we be like superheroes ourselves?

<u>World Book Day</u> Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March. We are dressing up as characters from either our <u>Traditional Tales</u> or our <u>Superheroes</u> topic.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- I will think about how I can be a 'real-life superhero', by helping to look after people in our class, solve problems and keep our classroom safe and tidy.
- > I will learn about ways to look after our local area, e.g. putting litter in the bin or recycling.
- I will learn how to stay safe at school, at home and when I am out and about.
- I will practise taking turns, negotiating and problem solving when taking part in small group activities.
- I will practise playing in our role play area with other children, understanding that we play in ways which respect each other, and listen to each other's ideas.

#### Maths

- > I will be using my super powers to add and take away numbers using objects.
- > I will begin to use a number line and to count on or back to find the answer.
- > I will be ordering numbers to 20 and beyond.
- > I will be securing my knowledge of 1 more and 1 less.
- > I will be exploring 3D shapes.
- I will begin to explore time and sequence simple events.

## Understanding the World

- > I will learn about 'real-life superheroes' who help us in our local community.
- > I will think about how I can look after our local area.
- > I will be exploring different materials and how they can be used.
- I will be investigating places, objects, materials and living things by using all my senses.
- > I will learn about Easter and find out how Christians celebrate the festival.

#### Physical Development

- > I will be exploring the hall equipment, moving around, over, under and through balancing equipment.
- > I will develop my fine motor skills through lots of activities, including 'Dough Disco'.
- I will practise handling and using tools appropriately and safely.
- > I will improve my throwing and catching skills and explore different equipment that challenges me.
- I will think about the differences in my body when I am exercising.

### **Expressive Arts and Design**

- > I will design my own superhero themed model.
- I will create my own superhero model using a range of junk that we are 'Reusing' to save the planet!
- > I will adapt my model to make improvements.
- I will explore different materials to make a cape for Super Dog
- > I will reuse something old and make it into something new.
- I will use colour, texture, shape, form and space in two or three dimensions.
- I will be exploring different musical instruments and creating super hero music.
- I will role-play with other children at our classroom 'Vets'.
