

Homework for the Half Term Holiday

In order for families to choose how they spend their time in their holidays, we don't give out compulsory homework (with the exception of still reading at least 5 times a week). However, we do provide the opportunity for those who want to carry on with their learning to do so.

Below is the list of topics each class will be covering next term. What we would like the children to do is to create something for their class topic board ready to put up sometime during the first week back. The board is intended to spark interest, enthusiasm and curiosity – a bit like *Pinterest* for those of you familiar with that.

Here are some ideas of what to do: take a photograph related to the topic; create some 'Did you knows?'; research an event or a character; write a story; make up some maths problems; paint a picture; collect some words like *Wordcloud*; visit somewhere and bring back a leaflet; cook something.

Y5 Sycamore Class: 'Why was Bristol bombed?' – a WWII local study
Y6 Cedar Class: 'What have the Victorians ever done for us?' - Victorian innovations, inventions and legacy of traditions
