English

The class text will be, Handa's surprise

Mathematics

In our maths, we will be revising place value. We will be looking at how numbers under 100 are made up of tens and ones and how this helps us generally in mathematics learning. In our mini maths (fluency) we will be concentrating on missing number problems.

Science
