

**English**

We will be reading our class text: **The Iron Man** by Ted Hughes

**Narrative**

This term the children will be reading and writing their own 'Journey' tale. We will be continuing to improve our character and setting descriptions focusing on interesting word choices and phrases.

**Non-fiction**

We will be continuing to use the Iron Man to consider how a human machine would work. This will link directly with our topic – The Human Machine.

In Maths this term we will be covering the following skills:

Furthering are knowledge of measurements by:

- Converting between different units of measure
- Using practical skills to help us convert

**Rounding to the nearest 100 and 1000**

- Revise place value and know how to round numbers up and down
- round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1,000

**Coordinates**

- Plot co-ordinates on a pair of axes and with equal scales
- Use coordinate cross-curricular

**Fractions including decimals**

- add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths
- compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places
- solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.

We will learn to:

- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

**Topic**

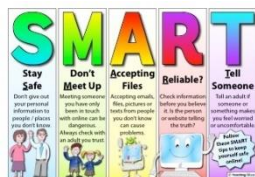
This term we will be expanding on our science topic to understand how the body works. We will be looking at ways to keep healthy and the importance of it.
