Headteacher's News

This week I would like to raise a couple of health and safety issues.

The safety issue concerns cycle helmets. We have recently increased our capacity to store bikes and scooters during the day; this is a great development and encourages the children to use them to come to school. However, we have had numerous reports of some of our older children cycling hazardously down the road after school, not only putting themselves, but other car users in danger. From talking to the children involved, it turns out that they are also not wearing cycle helmets. As your child's school we owe your children a duty of care to ensure they are safe. Consequently, we will be requiring any child who cycles to school in the future to wear a cycle helmet. Those not wearing helmets will be asked come on foot for their own safety.

The health issue concerns water. This week has been especially hot so it is has been even more important that we all drink lots of water. This year we have managed to get all of our water fountains working both indoors and out but ideally, each child needs their own water bottle so they can drink plenty throughout the day. Due to the tooth decay caused by drinks other than water, we do insist that water bottles contain just water (or ice).
