Headteacher's News

Homework and home reading are areas that we are currently making improvements to. For those of you whose children are in years 1 to 6, you will have noticed a slight change. This year we aim to make any home learning more tightly focused on basic skill development, for example, learning number bonds and multiplication tables thoroughly, learning spelling patterns and 'tricky' words. We hope that those of you whose children are using the new format are finding it valuable. Thank you for the comments you write in the homework books as these are extremely useful to the teachers. In Term 2, we will be looking at ways in which we can fine-tune what we do and ensure we have whole school consistency.

This week the children have been having tests or 'quizzes' using past SATs papers in Y2 and Y6, and NFER tests in Y3,4 and 5. We complete them at this time of year to identify any gaps really early on (so we can make our teaching really personalised) and to get the children used to taking time-constrained tests. Each year, we are proud to see the growing resilience of our young learners.

And finally, Lime class performed a super Harvest Assembly this morning. We had the added treat of Ladybirds children join us and they even sang a scarecrow song to the whole school! We have the Halloween disco to look forward to tonight.

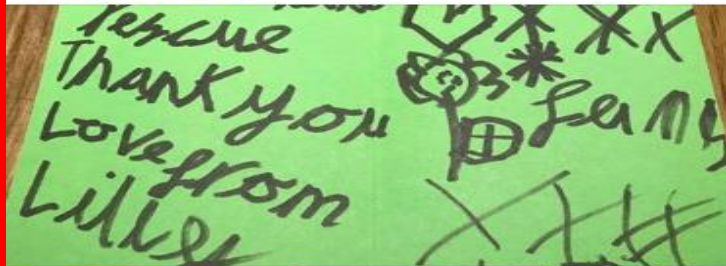
