Before and After School Reminder

Paying for School Visits



The teachers at Courtney strive to make the children's learning as meaningful and exciting as they can. As part of this, they organise visits to provide extra stimulus and expertise. On the letters for each trip we put that payment is a 'voluntary contribution' but definitely with the expectation that every family will pay. We never make a profit from school visits – the price we give is the cost of the coach (which is always expensive) plus entrance fees and costs for workshops. We never overcharge paying families to subsidise families who haven't paid; the overall cost is always divided equally between the number of children. Any shortfall is met with our limited school funds; which is why we will cancel any visit which will cost the school too much money. We do, therefore, hope that you will support your child by paying for these trips.

Of course, if you are genuinely experiencing financial hardship, then please do contact school to discuss options.
