We will learn too:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Calculate angles in triangles</li><li>• Measure accurately using protractors</li><li>• Compare different types of angles</li></ul>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Our focus is: <b>Forces</b></p> <p>Over the next term, we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object</li><li>• identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces</li><li>• recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.</li></ul>
