Headteacher's News

It seems very strange that the country has gone into lockdown and yet, for us, it is largely business as usual. We will try our very best to keep the whole school open but we do need to be prepared for bubbles having to close and for increased staffing issues due to self-isolation needs. I will endeavour to keep you as informed as much as I can. Next week, you will be having your 'meeting' with the class teacher albeit by phone rather than face-to-face. In advance, you will have received a set of targets personalised for your child, to help you know what they need to focus on as their 'next step' in Reading, Writing and Mathematics. The teachers will need to stick to the ten minute time

slots so please help them to keep to that by bringing up any questions you may have early on. Our teaching for this term will be adjusted to address any individual or whole class gaps identified after the testing period at the end of last term. In terms of statutory assessment, as far as we know at the moment: Y2 will be screened for their phonic knowledge at the end of this term; Y1 will be screened for phonics in June; Y2 and Y6 SATs will still be happening in May; and Y4 will be tested

on the multiplication facts in June.




RHS Design a Secret Garden Competition
