- Recognise the place value of each digit in number up to two decimal places.
- read, write, order and complete numbers to at least 1,000,000
- count forwards and backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any given number up to 1,000,000
- round any number up to 1,000,000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10,000 and 100,000
- Partition numbers and reason their understanding
- Order and compare measures

Topic

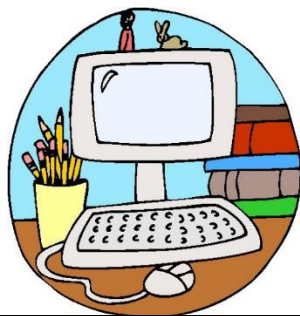
This term our topic question is **'What was it like to live in Victorian Britain?'**
