- Year 5/6 1:30-2:30pm

In the event of adverse weather conditions, you will be informed of cancellation through text message by 8.00am on the morning of the Courtney K. If we are fortunate enough to have warm, sunny weather please provide your child with sun hat, water bottle and sun screen (to be applied before school).

As in previous years, we will have powder paint that the children can throw and have thrown at them. Please read the list below in terms of clothing for that school day:

- All children must come to school wearing their Courtney K clothes **and** bring a change of clothes (PE kit) in a bag.
- Please ensure your children comes to school wearing sensible trainers that they can run in.
- Please ensure all long hair is tied back.
- If your child **does not** want paint thrown at them, they must come to school wearing their house t-shirt (*squirrel yellow*; *Deer blue*; *Badger red*; *Hedgehog purple*; *Fox orange*; *Otter green*.)
- If your child **does** want paint thrown at them, please send them in, in an old white t-shirt.
