Our work this term will continue to focus on Malorie Blackman's brilliant and incredibly moving text, "Pig Heart Boy." We will work towards a "rags to riches" tale and discussion essay as our two end of unit outcomes. As well as consolidating the skills already learnt across the year, we will be learning how to use colons in a list and use cohesion with paragraphs. Finally, our guided reading will build on the work we have done on note taking, distinguishing between fact and opinion and using evidence to back up our argument in debates.		 We kick off the term with a focus on statistics this term, which has links to our science work. This will include interpreting and drawing line graphs, as well as analysing tables, two-way tables and timetables. We will move on to "Measurement" as an overarching topic, which we will begin with perimeter and area. This will build on the work the children did in year 4, as well as bringing together all four operations and work with numbers up to three decimal places. As always there is a whole school focus on developing our children's reasoning and problem solving skills. 	 This term, we will be finishing off our work on "Animals including Humans" by looking at growth and development in humans over time. In addition, we will be focusing on building on our "Working Scientifically" skills, which are particularly important as the children prepare to move in to year 6. This will include identifying different types of enquiry, investigating how to answer them and carrying out scientific experiments. We will also explore different ways of displaying and analysing the results found.
RE Our question for this term is "What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?" We will look at their views on the journey of life, as well as identify the key beliefs that underpin Islam faith.
