At the end of Term I and beginning of Term 2, we will have a mini 3 week unit learning about WWI, 100 years on from the end of the war.

- Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

Our topic in PSHE (Jigsaw scheme of work) is: **Being me in my world** We will be able to: tell you a time when a first impression of someone changed as I got to know them; explain why it is good to accept people for who they are. The children will be studying the cave paintings created by Stone Age men, women and children. We will crawl under our classroom tables and draw on paper under them to recreate the conditions and atmosphere the people of the time would have experienced.
