






Courtney Primary - Topic Sheet- Bones and Bodies

English

Our class text will be: Krindlekrax by Philip Ridley

We will be learning the following grammar skills:

Use prepositions to express time and place.

Create and describe setting in narrative.

Use apostrophes for contractions.

Start to use paragraphs to group related ideas.

Create interest through the use of appropriate words and descriptive

Use a range of organisational features in fiction and non-fiction.

In Maths this term we will be covering the following skills: Finishing addition and subtraction

Add and subtract numbers mentally

Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using column addition and subtraction.

Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers. Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

Starting multiplication and division

Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables Write and calculate statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, Solve problems, including missing number problems, integer scaling problems and correspondence problems.

During this unit we will be learning to: add to and create our own branching database to answer questions, present data appropriately for a purpose and audience and use a datalogger to analyse the findings.

History


We are continuing our exploration of life during WWI and will be writing setting descriptions of the trenches and a recount of our visit to the church following our WWI Remembrance Day Service.



Science

Our focus in science is Animals including Humans. We will:

- identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.
- identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.





Key question: What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today?

We will be continuing to explore this question from last term by looking at, how different Christians celebrate Holy Communion and how Christians make a difference in their local community. We will also be exploring why people stand up against injustice because of their religion.
