#### **Headteacher's News**

One of the targets in this year's School Improvement Plan is to provide as many opportunities as we can to allow the children to work on their personal development. Part of that is to make sure that we develop the language of learning within the classroom. You may have heard your child talk about the 'Learning Pit' (when the children find an aspect of learning challenging but work through the feelings associated with difficulty until they get out of the pit with or without support) or 'Marvellous Mistakes' (when the children make a mistake but instead of feeling ashamed of getting something wrong they use it as a learning point for themselves and for the class). Please do feel free to use these phrases when you are supporting with homework.

Another aspect of personal development is to give the children opportunities to come out of their comfort zone and to learn how to win and lose. We are proud to say that we have taken part in at least one sporting event each week for this term – with the exception of the Kabaddi, which we reluctantly had to cancel due to a sickness bug sweeping through Y5.

On the last day of term, we will be holding a Courtney Talent Show. Again, this is for children not only to showcase hidden skills or talents, but for them to 'feel the fear but do it anyway'.

And finally, our lovely Mrs Belton in the office has become a nanna. Congratulations to the whole family.
