English

Our class text will be: Egyptian Cinderella by Shirley Climo

Maths

THE EGYPTIAN CINDERELLA

In Maths this term we will be covering the following skills:

Fractions and decimals

Fractions – add and subtract fractions with same denominator.

Fractions – tenths and hundredths.

Fractions - recognise and write decimal equivalents to 1/2,1/4,3/4.

Fractions – equivalent fractions.

Decimals including money; recapping ÷10 ÷100 ÷1000. Decimals - comparing decimals.
