

### **Outcomes Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) 2017-19**

At the end of Reception class, the children are assessed against agreed criteria. If a child has a Good Level of Development (GLD), this means that they are working at expected levels across the whole range of the EYFS curriculum. This does not measure progress from entry.

## Year 1 and Year 2 phonics 2017-19

At the end of Year 1, the children's knowledge of phonics is screened using a national Phonics Screener. This comprises of a list of 40 real and 'alien' words for them to read. Those children who did not meet the standard in Year 1 are re-screened in Year 2.

#### KS1 SATs Attainment 2017-19

At the end of Year 2, the children are assessed using Teacher Assessments. These are based on each child's performance in class and supported by tests (SATs) which are written by the government. The percentages below are for children who are working at the Expected level (EXS) and those who are working beyond that at Greater Depth Standard (GDS) with the exception of Science for which the highest standard is EXS. External moderators from the local authority ensure that our judgements are accurate.

**NB:** In 2019, we had some inwardly mobile children who joined our school in Terms 3 and 4. The second figure are the outcomes not including these pupils.

# KS2 SATs Tests (Reading & Mathematics) and Teacher Assessments (Writing & Science)

At the end of Year 6, the children all sit government tests (SATs) which are solely used to assess the end of year outcomes. The Writing and Science judgements are Teacher Assessments as there are no tests in these subjects. External moderators from the local authority ensure that our judgements are accurate.

In all subjects the children will either achieve the Expected Standard (EXS) or Greater Depth Standard (GDS) with the exception of Science for which the highest standard is EXS.

(In 2019, our Reading Expected outcomes were significantly below both what we were predicting and the outcomes of practice papers leading up to the SATs.)
