'Being an autistic teenager in a female body' An evening with Robyn Steward

Thursday 4 July 2019

At this event, Robyn will talk about her new book 'The autism friendly guide to periods', which is about puberty for autistic people in a female body and those who support them.



Robyn is autistic and has worked in autism for over 10 years, providing mentoring, consultancy and training all over the world including Russia, Australia and USA. She is an honorary research associate at CRAE (Centre for Research in Autism and Education) at University College, London and has a Radio 4 podcast series with Jamie Knight who is also autistic. Robyn is also author of, 'The independent woman's handbook for super safe living on the autistic spectrum.'

The talk will offer practical strategies covering: gender (non-binary and trans), periods, moods, body changes, sex and masturbation, hygiene, motivating your roadmap and trust.
