

Literacy

We will continue to learn new sounds and tricky words and will introduce 'digraphs' (two letters make one sound e.g. 'ee', 'sh'.)



We will explore the characters and events in the 'Three Little Pigs'. We will plan and create our own version of the characters in the story.



Maths

Children will consolidate their basic skills in counting. recognising and ordering numbers up to 20.

We will start to explore adding by finding the total of two groups of objects. We will begin to **subtract** single digits using resources

Children will explore how a number can be made by using two other numbers eg 1 and 2 make 3. We will use playdoh and lots of loose parts to help us understand this concept.









Personal. Social and Emotional **Development**

This term's whole-school focus is on learning about dreams and goals. We will talk about New Years' Resolutions and think about our own goals and how we can work towards them.

Through all our activities we will continue to practise taking turns, sharing and thinking of others' feelings.

We will practise working in a team, for instance building a house for the Three Little Pigs.

Communication and Language

Children will learn to re-tell traditional stories.

especially 'The Three Little Pigs', and will talk to others about their own favourite stories

We will have lots of fun acting out traditional stories using masks, props or puppets in our puppet theatre.

Understanding the World

Children will test which material is the strongest for making a house for the Three Little Pigs.

We will explore technology, for instance taking photos and recording ourselves on electronic devices

Physical Development

P.E. will continue on Fridays. Please make sure your child is wearing their kit and if needed has their hair tied back and earrings removed. This term we will be focusing on aiming accurately to improve our ball skills.

We will keep developing our finger strength and coordination so that we can form letters correctly.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will develop our imaginative play in our 'Fairy Tale Cottage' role-play area.

Children will explore the materials in the story of the 'Three Little Pigs' and use them to make collages and sculptures. We will design and make our own 'junk' houses.

In music sessions we will be exploring the instruments in the orchestra
