Covid Update

Thank you for all of your continued efforts to make Courtney as safe as it can be. As a staff team, we really appreciate that you have worked with us to stick to the 'rules'.

- Although we are still in an area with relatively lower confirmed Covid cases, as you are no doubt aware, there are growing numbers including contacts of people in our school community. Please do keep sticking to the guidance Hands, Face, Space to help keep the virus away from our school.
- During the school holiday, if your child is a confirmed case please can you EMAIL the school don't leave an answer phone message and someone will check them each day. Could we also ask you to contact the local authority who have set up a special half-term contact who you need to inform if you have a confirmed case. The school will then work with the Local Authority to decide who needs to self-isolate. (They are sending us details of this. We will send them out to you as soon as we know.)
- Remember, if any of you do go away on holiday, you will need to adhere to the latest quarantine guidance from the government. Please do not go to a country where you know 2 week self-isolation will be needed afterwards.

Parking

We have had reports of some very dangerous parking with some cars being parked on the actual **zig-zags**, some on the **school** word, some on **double yellow lines** and some doing very very dangerous **three point turns** very close to the entrance the children use to walk into school. Staff members have also complained that their vision trying to get in and out of school is often blocked by vehicles parked in illegal places. Saving an extra few minutes by not having to walk a few metres is simply not worth the risk.



Please can we urge you to park safely and to help keep our precious children safe.


