We will also spend a week focusing on poetry and two weeks on Non fiction writing.


We will learn the following skills to enrich our writing: using commas in lists, using expended noun phrases, character descriptions using a mixture of simple and compound sentences and using apostrophes for possession. We will be working on our dictionary skills to encourage the children's spelling and independence in class.

Maths

In maths this term we will be focusing on Place Value. The following objectives will be taught.

- count in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1000
- find 1000 more or less than a given number
- count backwards through zero to include negative numbers •
- recognise the place value of each digit in a four-digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones)
- order and compare numbers beyond 1000
- identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations
- round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000
- solve number and practical problems that involve all of the above and with increasingly large positive numbers
- read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C) and know that over time, the numeral system changed to include the concept of zero and place value
