





<p>Writing</p> <p>Poetry</p> <p>We will begin our writing by exploring a collection of poems curated by Julia Donaldson to inspire us to write and perform poetry around the theme of ‘Where do I live?’ Children will learn to recognise some of the features of poetry including rhythm and rhyme as well as using onomatopoeia.</p> <p>In addition, Oak class will continue to work on fundamental skills of transcription, sentence construction and vocabulary choice through both fiction and non fiction writing.</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>During the Winter Term, children grew in confidence and fluency using numbers to 100 and have methods to add and subtract. Oak class also understand the value of different notes and coins and can make different amounts of money. At the start of the Spring Term, the class will be learning to multiply and divide, looking for patterns and clues from their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p> 	<p>Science</p> <p>This half term, children study Animal (including humans), and notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.</p> <p>Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air). Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.</p> 
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Topic: Where do I live?

<p>Geography</p> <p>During this topic, the children will study the UK & a contrasting non European environment Children will create sketch maps of the school and local area, name the four points of a compass and plan a simple route around the local area. They will study the UK including using an atlas to find and name the four countries and capital cities. They will also use an atlas to locate the seven continents, 5 major oceans and begin to ask geographical questions like ‘Where is it?’, ‘What is this place like?’ and ‘How near or far is a place?’</p> <p>Music</p> <p>This term the children will begin to learn about ‘The History of Music’. We will also continue to learn and sing songs together in class and during assembly time as a whole school.</p> <p>PE</p> <p>This terms focus will be Gymnastics where the children will develop balances and rolls, landing on two feet and using equipment safely. PE will be on a Tuesdays with our specialist sports coach and with Mr Lord (4Real PE) and on a Thursday.</p>
