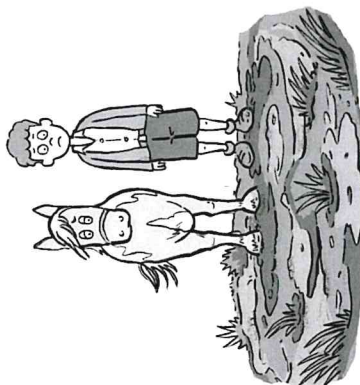


Sam lives on a farm. His dad is a farmer. Sam's dad asks Sam to help him on the farm.



Sam and Mop are sad. They want to play in the mud.

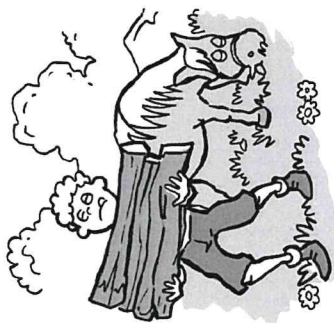


Sam has to get some grass for Mop.

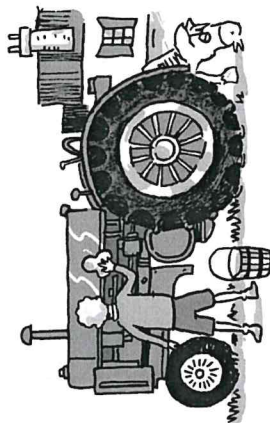


Then he gets the eggs.

A Good Night's Sleep

After a busy day of school, work or play, everyone needs a good night's sleep in bed.

Most beds are made of two parts. The soft part, where people lie, is called a mattress. The mattress usually sits on top of a strong piece of wood or metal. 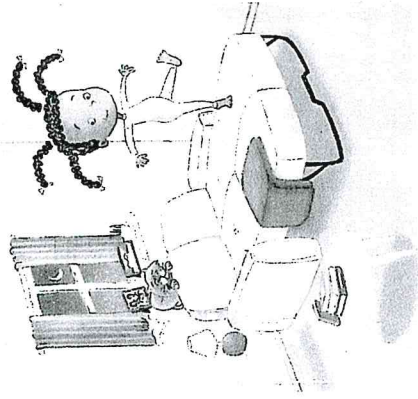

Sofa Bed

Sofa beds are a sofa and bed all in one! They can be used as a sofa in the day and unfolded to make a bed at night. In the morning, the bed can be rolled back into the sofa again. They are useful in small homes where there is not a lot of room.

Many sofa beds also have a box underneath where you can put books, toys or clothes. These sofa beds can be heavy and hard to move around.

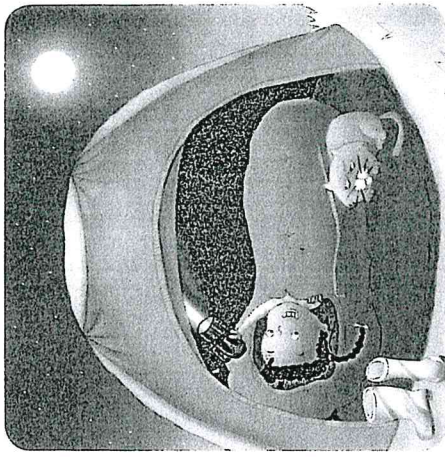

Sleeping bags are used by explorers because they can be used in many different places: from hot jungles to cold mountain tops.



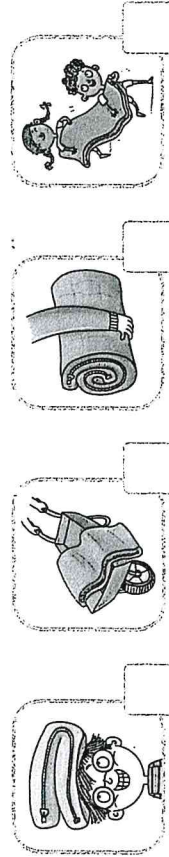

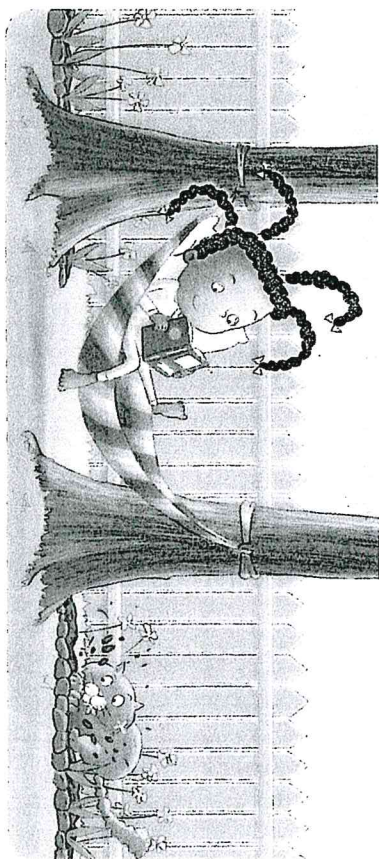

Hammock
