

Application to Primary School 2021/2022

Just a reminder from the last newsletter- the closing date to apply for entry into primary school in September 2021 is 15 January 2021. We are close to having a full set of 1st choices so our spaces are filling up! This is for any younger siblings born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017. It is important to apply ontime as siblings are not guaranteed a place at the older child's school and the school may fill up with on-time applications making it harder for late applicants. It is unlikely you will hear back regarding your space until after the deadline.

Applications should be made to the local authority where the child lives; regardless of the location of the school they are requesting. Greater Accessing Home Learning

If you have an Xbox or PS4 you are able to access Google Classrooms through them by following the instructions below.



- Turn on PS4
 Use your controller to scroll to the far right of the bar
- with games to *Library*
- Select *Library* application
