aerial view	a view from above
capital city	the main city where the government sits
city	an urban area larger than a town
compass point	any of the main points of a compass: north, south, east and west
county	a region of a country with its own local government
country	an area of land that is controlled by its own government
flag	a design with colours and symbols which represents a particular country
human geography	features of land that have been impacted by human activity
island	a piece of land that is completely surrounded by water
Great Britain	the large island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales
physical geography	natural features of land
sea	a large area of salty water that is part of an ocean
town	an urban area larger than a village but smaller than a city
United Kingdom	The UK, is officially known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. It includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
village	a small group of homes, perhaps with a shop, church and school often in the countryside
