English

Our class text will be: Krindlekrax by Philip

Ridley We will be learning the following grammar

skills: Use prepositions to express time and place.

Create and describe setting in narrative.

Use apostrophes for contractions.

Start to use paragraphs to group related ideas.

Create interest through the use of appropriate words and descriptive phrases.

Use a range of organisational features in fiction and non-fiction.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be covering the following skills: Repeating addition and subtraction for fluency

Add and subtract numbers mentally

Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using column addition and subtraction.

Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers. Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

Starting multiplication and division

Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables Write and calculate statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, Solve problems, including missing number problems, integer scaling problems and correspondence problems.

Computing T2

We will be using spreadsheets and/or potentially learning more about home learning.

During this unit we will be learning to: create basic formulas in spreadsheets, including shortcuts and in the context of scientific study.

Music

his term the children will be studying singing (or the voice as an instrument) whilst both listening to a range of different singers and discussing how the voice is used with the correct terminology.



Science

Our focus in science is Animals including Humans. We will:

identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.





Key question: What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today?

We will be continuing to explore this question from last term by looking at, how different Christians celebrate Holy Communion and how Christians make a difference in their local community. We will also be exploring why people stand up against injustice because of their religion.



Art and DT

In art we will studying the artist Giacometti and having a go at creating our own sculptures.
In DT we will be creating bionic body parts using string, straws, card and elastic bands to represent bones, ligaments and muscles.



PΕ

During P.E this term, we will be learning Netball (weather dependent) or completing in class circuits. In Netball they will learn the rules, three types of pass (chest, bounce and shoulder) and defending and attacking techniques too.

We will play small scale games (3v3) and build on the invasion and positional sense learnt in hockey during term I
