<u>English</u>

In English, we are reading The Lighthouse Keeper's Christmas.



We will be learning how to use question marks and exclamation marks along with full stops to punctuate our sentences. We will also continue developing our descriptive writing with adjectives.

In phonics we have moved on to our phase 5 sounds!



In maths this term, our topics are going to be addition & subtraction, geometry and shape.

We will be adding and subtracting numbers and money and improving our ability to work out word problems.

Then we shall have a look at 2D and 3D shapes and pattern.

Music, Art and DT


In art we are going to continue working on our sketching skills. We will complete some lovely lighthouse paintings and hopefully build lighthouse sculptures.
