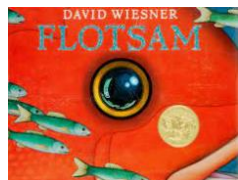


English

Our **Fiction text** this term is 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner. This is wordless book. We will be using the wonderful illustrations to develop our inference skills. We will be developing a sub plot using fronted adverbials, developing interesting vocabulary and descriptive phrases and using prepositions.



Our **Non Fiction text** will be a book called 'What a Waste.' We will be developing our understanding of flotsam and looking at plastic pollution. We will explore a range of skills which will help us to write a persuasive letter. We will also be writing **Poetry** about plastic pollution.

Maths

We will be continuing to focus on the following skills using **multiplication** and division: recognise and use factor pairs and commutativity in mental calculations multiply two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using formal written layout solve problems involving multiplying and adding, including using the distributive law to multiply two digit numbers by one digit, integer scaling problems and harder correspondence problems such as n objects are connected to m objects.

We will move on to calculating and comparing **area** towards the end of term 4.

**Science**

Our topic this term is "**sound**." By the end of the unit children will be able to:

- Describe sounds around them.
- Identify high and low sounds.
- Identify loud and quiet sounds.
- Observe how different sounds are made.
- Describe how sounds change over distance.
- Participate in an investigation to find the best material for absorbing sound.
- Answer questions based on their learning using prompts.
- Create a musical instrument that will play different sounds.
- Predict what will happen in an investigation.
- Make observations.

Our learning this term will include:

Using google earth and inference skills to locate India.

We will be exploring key physical features within India: Himalayas, Ganges, topography.

We will identify the largest cities in India and compare their human features.

We will be exploring the weather and climate in India.
