

Maths

<u>English</u>

Topic

In English, we are reading The Storm Whale. We will also be looking at some whale rescue videos and non fiction texts around whales.



We will be concentrating on developing our vocabulary and our ability to write longer sentences using 'and.' We will be learning about character and settings and begin to describe them.

We will also be learning to use capital letters and full stops

In phonics we will be recapping our sounds from reception and then move on to our phase 5 sounds!





This term, we are going to be looking at how holidays have changed over time. We are going to specifically look at beach holidays and link this to our whale story in English. We will also be looking at the geography of the UK, the seven continents and oceans.



This term, our Science topic is 'materials,' which we will link to our work in English, Art/DT and History.

We will be looking at the properties and uses of various materials, and learn how to describe them.
